It bears, however, a very insignificant fruit, only about the size of a pea, and orange-yellow when ripe. The branches are covered with a whitish bark. The leaves 3 to 4 inches long, are from 1 to 2 inches broad; the peduncles are about an inch in length. The form of the leaves are almost similar with those of the Orange, elliptic and narrower below, with a rounded summit, and a very short, rather acute, projecting point or acumination,...
