Beyond the FHLBank Systems status as a GSE, the unique characteristics of FHLBank capital and the potential for risk taking within the System heighten the importance of supervisory oversight by FHFB. First, even after the new capital structure is in place, FHLBank capital will be less permanent than perpetual equity stock. Therefore, more so than other regulators, FHFB must be prepared to act in case a FHLBanks financial condition weakens.
